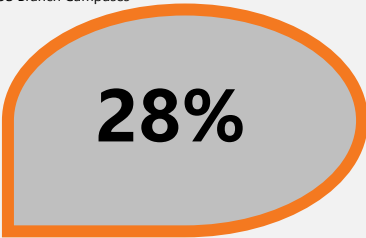

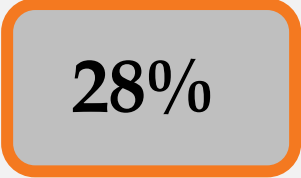

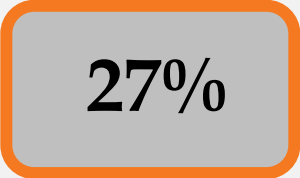

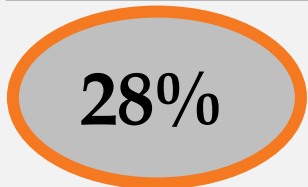
**Graduation Rate

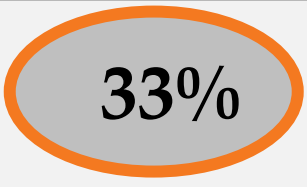


**Graduation Rate

without Pell Grant

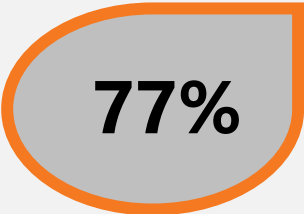
