The curriculum design of the Social Work Baccalaureate program at the Universidad del Turabo responds to an outcome performance approach. The foundations of our curricular design are familiar with the required Council on Social Work competencies listed in the Educational Accreditation Standards (2015). Students of the Social Work Program at the University of Turabo demonstrated the necessary knowledge, values, skills and cognitive and affective processes, associated with each competency at the generalist level of practice. Table "Form AS4 (B)" reflects the percentage of students meeting the parameters established by each of the competencies required by the CSW

Form AS4 (B)

All Council on Social Work Education programs measure and report student learning outcomes. Students are assessed on their mastery of the competencies that comprise the accreditation standards of the Council on Social Work Education. These competencies are dimensions of social work practice that all social workers are expected to master during their professional training. A measurement benchmark is set by the social work programs for each competency. An assessment score at or above that benchmark is considered by the program to represent mastery of that particular competency.
